# **GRAINS MARKET**

In the reporting period, domestic grain prices in Ukraine again significantly strengthened in all positions, without exception. Prices rose amid another strengthening of the export market. At the same time, growth was limited by a slight strengthening of the national currency. Domestic demand for flour and cereals (groats) is somewhat weakened.

Processors purchasing prices for food wheat in the reporting period again increased against the backdrop of another rise in export prices. It should be noted that the Government began to actively intervene in the market in order to stabilize prices. Between traders and the government agreed on a new volume of wheat exports this season - 20.2 million tons. State company DPZKU and the Agrarian Fund began processing wheat for flour in order to saturate the domestic market and stabilize prices. The AMCU monitors food prices (including flour and cereals) in retail chains.

Global wheat market was in a mixed price trend last reporting week. Wheat quotes in Chicago fell after a significant increase a week earlier. The decline took place against the backdrop of a strengthening US dollar, forecasts of large global wheat production in 2020 and the extension of quarantine in the United States until the end of April. The fall was supported by a decline in soy and corn quotes.

At the same time, the decline was limited by good export and domestic demand, a possible limitation of exports from the Black Sea region and quarterly reports of the USDA, in which forecasts for sown area and reserve estimates for March 1 turned out to be lower than market expectations

Quotes of HRW wheat in Kansas City and spring wheat in Minneapolis also declined.

Wheat quotes in Paris fell to the level of a weekly low under pressure from Chicago, strengthening EURO and the rapid spread of coronavirus. Moreover, the decline was limited by strong export demand and rising prices in the Black Sea region.

In the Black Sea region, wheat prices (12.5%) rose by about USD12/t in the reporting week. Prices rose amid strong domestic and export demand, as well as concerns about export restrictions in Russia, Ukraine and Kazakhstan. In addition, logistical problems due to the spread of coronavirus contribute to growth. By the middle of the current calendar week, wheat prices in the Black Sea region were at the level of USD220-227/t, FOB for deliveries in May.

In Ukraine, 12.5% wheat export prices have grown by USD12/t to USD220-225/t, FOB, Black sea port, May shipments. Prices for wheat (11.5%) have increased by USD11/t to the level of USD218-223/t, FOB. Feed wheat prices have increased by USD11/t and reached level of USD213-218/t, FOB.

Export prices for corn have increased by USD9/t and by the end of the reporting period were in the range of USD180-185/t, FOB for deliveries in May. Growth occurred against the backdrop strong domestic and export demand.

This week export prices for feed barley have not changed and by the end of the reporting period were in the range of USD180-185/t, FOB, Black Sea ports for May deliveries.

Last week, pea prices again rose slightly in the domestic market, but fell in export. On EXW terms, yellow peas were offered at UAH 5800-6600/t (+UAH100/t), depending on the lot size, terms of payment and the region. The level of purchase prices for CPT port is UAH6600-7000/t(+UAH200/t) (inc. VAT) depending on the port. Export prices – USD200-210/t, CPT port, Black Sea (-USD15/t).

As of this week, traders have set their grains' export forward prices:

- 12.5% wheat USD220-225/t, FOB, Apr/May shipments;
- 11.5% wheat USD218-223/t, FOB, Apr/May shipments;
- feed wheat USD213-218/t, FOB, Apr/May shipments;
- feed barley USD179-185/t, FOB, Apr/May shipments;
- corn USD180-185/t, FOB, Apr/May shipments.







# OILSEEDS & OILS MARKET

In the reporting period, domestic prices for oilseeds in Ukraine were in a mixed trend. Prices for sunflower seeds and soybeans rose again amid a weakening national currency and a strengthening export market for vegetable oils and meal. Rape seed prices have not changed, although quotes in Paris have risen. There is practically no trade in rapeseeds, traders are already focusing on the purchase of seeds of a new crop.

Export prices for rapeseed have increased by USD15/t during the reporting period and by the end of the reporting week the estimated price level was USD390-400/t, FOB for deliveries in May.

Export prices for sunflower seeds have increased by USD15/t and by the end of the reporting period were in the range of USD380-390/t, FOB, for supplies in May.

Export prices for soybeans have increased by USD10/t and by the end of the reporting period were in the range of USD380-390/t, FOB for deliveries in Apr/May.

Global vegetable oil market was in a mixed price trend last reporting week. Rape, palm and sunflower oil prices and quotes rose amid improved export demand and logistical problems caused by the coronavirus pandemics. At the same time, growth was limited by a decrease in crude oil quotes and a drop in demand for biodiesel. Soybean oil quotes fell amid weakening soybean quotes, weakening crude oil market, as well as good data on soybean processing in the US, which were higher than analysts' expectations.

Export market of sunflower oil in Ukraine in the reporting time strengthened in price terms again. Prices rose by about USD5/t. By the end of the reporting time, export prices for crude sunflower oil from Ukraine were in the range of USD650-670/t, FOB, ports of the Black Sea for deliveries in May. Supply prices for deliveries in June are about USD15-20/t higher.

Prices for crude sunflower oil in India for the reporting period have increased by USD15/t and by the end of the reporting period Ukrainian crude sun oil demand/offer prices (CIF, Indian sea ports) were:

- USD725-740/t, CIF, May/Jun shipments;
- USD740-755/t, CIF, Jul/Aug/Sep shipments;
- USD740-750/t, CIF, Oct/Nov/Dec shipments.

During the reporting period, export prices for sunflower meal (in pellets) have increased by USD10/t to USD205-210/t, FOB. Domestic prices for meal and pellets have increased slightly.

Domestic prices for sunflower and soybean oil rose amid a strengthening export market and a weakening hryvnia. Soybean meal and pellets prices have also risen.







